CLINICS:

Antenatal Clinic
Tuesday and Thursday 14.00 - 17.40
Patients are seen by the midwife at the clinics
by appointment and also by the doctors during
surgery hours.

Child Health Clinics
Monday 9.30 - 10.30
Wednesday & Friday 9.30 - 11.30
At this open clinic a health visitor is available to
give advice and support re: your baby/child's
health, growth and development.

Asthma Clinic
This is run by the practice nurse in conjunction
with the doctors, by appointment only.

Diabetic Clinic
This is run by the practice nurse in conjunction
with the doctors, by appointment only.

Family Planning
Contraceptive care is provided by all the doctors
during surgery hours.

Well Women Clinic
This clinic is run by the nurses and health visitors
for smears, postnatal checks and discussion for
women's health issues.

Minor Surgery
The doctors carry out minor surgical procedures
at the surgery by appointment and they will be
happy to advise you on this.

The question is, Do You Care? Nothing to fear in a Patients' Questionnaire

The practice will be endeavouring to collect email addresses of patients who will be invited to participate in a new patient questionnaire. There is guidance on how a practice should involve patients in this new venture. It starts with the following list of common questions and answers. The practice will be considering how to implement and progress this in discussion with the PPG.

Why are you asking people for their contact details?

We would like to be able to contact people occasionally to ask them questions about the surgery and how well we are doing to identify areas for improvement.

Will my doctor see this information?

This information is purely to contact patients to ask them questions about the surgery, how well we are doing and ensure changes that are being made are patient focused. If your doctor is responsible for making some of the changes in the surgery they might see general patient feedback.

Will the questions you ask me be medical or personal?

We will only ask general questions about the practice, such as short questionnaires.

Who else will be able to access my contact details?

Your contact details will be kept safely and securely and will only be used for this purpose and will not be shared with anyone else.

How often will you contact me?

Not very often but probably not more than annually.

What is a patient group/patient participation group?

This is a group of volunteer patients who are involved in making sure the surgery provides the services its patients need.

Do I have to leave my contact details?

No, but if you change your mind, please let us know.

What if I no longer wish to be on the contact list or leave the surgery?

We will ask you to let us know by email if you do not wish to receive further messages.
