Choose and Book Referral System

A few years ago, patient choice was championed by this new highly secure computer system whereby a patient receives a booking letter from the surgery 7-10 days after agreeing a referral with a Doctor or Nurse. On the letter, there is a central booking system telephone number, together with a description of the type of clinic required and a pass-

word. The patient (or their representative) rings to speak to an operator who offers suitable appointments with a specialist at a hospital of their choice. Once an appointment is agreed, the referral letter is sent electronically to the specialist. Not all specialists are available through Choose and Book, but please ask your Doctor or Nurse Practitioner if there would be an advantage in using the system for any referrals suggested.

Travel Advice

At this time of year, many people are looking forward to a summer holiday overseas. If you think you require vaccinations or malaria tablets, Sister Elaine Adamson at the Practice advises that you arrange an appointment with one of our nurses at as far in advance as possible as it takes at least 6 weeks to receive some courses of vaccinations or for immunity to develop before a holiday. The cost of providing Yellow fever vaccinations and Malaria prescriptions is available at reception.
